Toronto Playgrounds Baseball Association 2025 House League Division Schedule

Below you will find the information for the 2025 House League season for each age division in terms of the days/times/locations for games and practices. Please note, Toronto Playgrounds Baseball Association reserves the right to make changes to this schedule as needed.

In the Tee Ball and Rookie Ball divisions there is a choice of game nights so please read the information carefully before registering. If you have any questions, please email us at info@tpbaseball.ca.

05U and 07U Tee Ball (2018-2021)

For the 2025 season, we will again be offering two divisions of Tee Ball – **05U Junior Tee Ball** is for players born in 2020 and 2021, and **07U Senior Tee Ball** is for players born in 2018 and 2019. For the 2025 season, we are offering Junior and Senior Tee Ball divisions on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Parents will register for one of those days. If there is sufficient interest and players on the waiting list we will open up another day.

05U Junior Tee Ball games will start at 5:30 pm, and 07U Senior Tee Ball games will start at 6:30 pm.

There won't be scheduled team practices once the regular season starts. There will be two or three scheduled team practices during the pre-season schedule. We are planning to schedule optional practices that are open to all players on some weekends for players who may want to have more opportunities to develop their skills.

All pre-season practices, regular season games, and weekend open practices will take place at the Eggleton Park Tee Ball diamonds, which are located just south of Harbord Street between Grace Street and Montrose Avenue (beside the Montrose Public School schoolyard).

The pre-season will run from early May (specific start date is dependent on field conditions) to Thursday, May 15th. The Tee Ball division regular season will commence on Tuesday May 20th. The season will conclude with a Tee Ball Celebration Day for each team in early September.

08U and 09U Rookie Ball (2016 and 2017)

For the 2025 season we will again be offering two divisions of Rookie Ball – **08U Junior Rookie Ball** is for players born in 2017 and **09U Senior Rookie Ball** is for players born in 2016. For the 2025 season, we are offering two choices of game day for both the Junior and Senior Rookie Ball divisions. Players will register for one of the following four divisions.

- The 08U Junior Rookie Ball Thursday division will play every Thursday and practice every second Tuesday. Games will be every Thursday at 5:45 pm. The games will take place at Christie Pits diamond 3 and the Bickford South diamond. The regular season schedule will list where the game is each week. Tuesday practices will take place at the Bickford South diamond from 5:30 to 6:45 pm.
- The 08U Junior Rookie Ball Friday division will play every Friday and practice every second Wednesday. Games will be at 5:45 and 7:00 p.m. at Christie Pits diamond 3 (each team will play some games at each time). Wednesday practices will take place at Christie Pits diamond 2 from 5:15 to 6:30 pm.
- The 09U Senior Rookie Ball Monday division will play every Monday and practice every second Wednesday. Games will be played each Monday at 5:45 and 7:00 pm (each team will play some games at each time). The games will take place at the Bickford South diamond. Wednesday practices will take place at the Bickford South diamond from 5:30 to 6:45 pm.
- The 09U Senior Rookie Ball Thursday division will play every Thursday and practice every second Monday. Games will be every Thursday at 7:00 pm at either the Bickford South diamond or Christie Pits diamond 3 (each team plays games at each diamond). Monday practices will take place at the Dovercourt diamond from 5:15 to 6:30 pm.

There will be evaluation sessions arranged for players registered in all Rookie Ball divisions. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. We are planning to hold some evaluation sessions indoors in March and April, as well as having outdoor sessions take place sometime in mid- to late April. Parents will receive information as to the dates, times, and location of these sessions as they are confirmed.

The pre-season will run from early May (specific start date is dependent on field conditions) to Thursday, May 15th. There will be two or three scheduled team practices during the pre-season. Weekend clinics in May and June will also be held so the Rookie Ball players can further develop their skills. The Rookie Ball regular season will commence on Tuesday May 20th. The Rookie Ball season will wrap up with the Rookie Ball Celebration Day in early September (the precise format/date(s) will be confirmed when the regular season schedule is released in April.)

11U Mosquito (2014 and 2015)

For the 2025 season the **11U Mosquito** division is for players born in 2014 and 2015. In 2025 the 11U Mosquito division will take place on Mondays and Wednesdays. So, **Mondays and Wednesdays are the days each week that 11U Mosquito players will need to commit to in order to participate in house league.**

As was the case the past number of seasons, while there will be 11U Mosquito house league every Monday and every Wednesday, all teams will play some games on Mondays and some games on Wednesdays (alternating each week). Practices will always be on Mondays. All teams will have a game every week and a practice every second week. So, all teams will have either a game or practice scheduled every Monday, and all teams will have a game scheduled on Wednesday the weeks they practice on Mondays.

The teams in the 11U Mosquito division will be divided into two groups, and each team will play all of the other teams in their group (but not teams in the other group) during the regular season. Teams from the two groups will play each other during the End-of-Season House League tournament in September ("September Madness").

Games and practices in the 11U Mosquito division will take place at a number of diamonds in the community: Christie Pits diamonds 2 and 3, the Dovercourt diamond, and Trinity diamond 2 (in Trinity Bellwood Park). The start times for the games will range from 5:45 to 7:30 pm. Start times for practices will range from 5:30 to 7:00 pm.

Games will run from 1.5 hours to 1.75 hours, and practices will run for 1.5 hours. The schedule will be created so that all teams will play/practice at all of those diamonds and start times during the course of the season.

There will be evaluation sessions arranged for players registered in the 11U Mosquito division. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. We are planning to hold some evaluation sessions indoors in March and April, as well as having outdoor sessions take place sometime in mid- to late April. Parents will receive information as to the dates, times, and location of these sessions as they are confirmed.

13U Peewee (2012 and 2013)

For the 2025 season the **13U Peewee** division is for players born in 2012 and 2013. In 2025 the 13U Peewee division will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays. So, **Tuesdays and Thursdays are the days each week that 13U Peewee players will need to commit to in order to participate in house league.**

As was the case the past number of seasons, while there will be 13U Peewee house league every Tuesday and also every Thursday, all teams will play some games on Tuesdays and some games on Thursdays (alternating each week). Practices will always be on Thursdays. All teams will have a game every week and a practice every second week. So, all teams will have either a game or practice scheduled every Thursday, and all teams will have a game scheduled on Tuesday the weeks they practice on Thursday.

The teams in the 13U Peewee division will be divided into two groups, and each team will play all of the other teams in their group (but not teams in the other group) during the regular season. Teams from the two groups will play each other during the End-of-Season House League tournament in September ("September Madness").

Games and practices in the 13U Peewee division will take place at a number of diamonds in the community: Christie Pits diamonds 2 and 3, the Dovercourt diamond, and Trinity Bellwood diamond 2 (in Trinity Bellwood Park). The start times for the games will range from 5:45 to 8:00 pm. The start times for the practices will range from 5:30 to 8:15 pm.

Games will run from 1.5 hours to 1.75 hours, and practices will run for 1.5 hours. The schedule will be created so that all teams will play/practice at all of those diamonds and start times during the course of the season.

There will be evaluation sessions arranged for players registered in the 13U Peewee division. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. We are planning to hold some evaluation sessions indoors in March and April, as well as having outdoor sessions take place sometime in mid- to late April. Parents will receive information as to the dates, times, and location of these sessions as they are confirmed.

The pre-season will run from early May (specific start date is dependent on field conditions) to Thursday, May 15th. There will be two or three scheduled team practices during the pre-season schedule. We will also be running weekend clinics in May and June so the 13U Peewee players can further develop their skills. 15U Bantam (2010 and 2011) and 18U Varsity (2007/2008/2009)

For the 2025 season, the **15U Bantam** division is for players born in 2010 and 2011, and the **18U Varsity** division is for players born in 2007, 2008, and 2009. There will be one 15U Bantam division and one 18U Varsity division. There will be four teams in the 18U Varsity division. There will be either four or six teams in the 15U Bantam division...the decision as to whether we add two teams to have six will depend largely on the registration numbers we have once online registration opens.

Since there is only one available diamond with a mound there will be 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity games played on more than one day each week. The days on which there will always be both a 15U Bantam game and a 18U Varsity game scheduled are Sunday and Monday. On Sundays and Mondays there will be a 15U Bantam game starting at 6:00 pm and the 18U Varsity game will start at 8:00 pm. The 18U Varsity teams will be scheduled for one game a week. The 15U Bantam teams will also be scheduled for one game a week. If we end up having six 15U Bantam teams we are planning to play most of the additional third games on Sunday afternoon.

We will be announcing the practice times and days for the 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity house league divisions by mid-May. While some practices will be at Christie Pits diamond 1, others will likely be at Christie Pits diamond 2.

There will be evaluation sessions arranged for players registered in the Bantam and Varsity divisions. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. These sessions will take place sometime in mid- to late April. Parents will receive information in early April as to the dates, times, and location of these sessions.

The pre-season will run from early May (specific start date is dependent on field conditions) to Thursday, May 15th. There will be two or three scheduled team practices during the pre-season schedule. We will also be running weekend clinics in May and June so the 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity players can further develop their skills. The 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity division regular seasons will commence on Sunday May 25th and will wrap up at the conclusion of our end-of-season "September Madness" house league tournament.
