

Toronto Playgrounds Baseball Association 2026 House League Division Schedule

Below you will find the information for the 2026 House League season for each age division in terms of the days/times/locations for games and practices. Please note, Toronto Playgrounds Baseball Association reserves the right to make changes to this schedule as needed.

In the Tee Ball and Rookie Ball divisions there is a choice of game nights so please read the information carefully before registering. If you have any questions, please email us at info@tpbaseball.ca.

05U and 07U Tee Ball (2022-2019)

For the 2026 season, we will again be offering two divisions of Tee Ball – **05U Junior Tee Ball is for players born in 2021 and 2022**, and **07U Senior Tee Ball is for players born in 2019 and 2020**.

For the 2026 season, we are offering Junior and Senior Tee Ball divisions on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Parents will register for one of those days. **If there is enough interest and players on the waiting list, we will open up Monday as well.** If there is not enough interest to appropriately fill four divisions, TP Baseball reserves the right to cancel one day and assign people who had registered for that day to the alternate day they most prefer.

05U Junior Tee Ball games will start at 5:30 pm, and 07U Senior Tee Ball games will start at 6:30 pm.

All pre-season practices, regular season games, and weekend open practices will take place at the **Eggleton Park Tee Ball diamonds**, which are located just south of Harbord Street between Grace Street and Montrose Avenue (beside the Montrose Public School schoolyard).

There will be two or three scheduled team practices during the pre-season schedule, which will run, weather and field conditions permitting, from Monday April 27th to Thursday May 14th. Those practices will take place on the day that parents registered for. There won't be scheduled team practices for Tee Ball teams once the regular season starts. We are planning to schedule optional practices that are open to all players on some weekends for players who are really keen to have more opportunities to develop their skills.

The Tee Ball division regular season will commence on Tuesday May 19th. The season will conclude for each team with a Tee Ball Celebration Day game, which will take place on their usual day during the week after Labour Day in September.

08U and 09U Rookie Ball (2018 and 2017)

For the 2026 season we will again be offering **two divisions of Rookie Ball** – **08U Junior Rookie Ball is for players born in 2018** and **09U Senior Rookie Ball is for players born in 2017**. For the 2026 season, we are offering two choices of game day for both the Junior and Senior Rookie Ball divisions. **Players will register for one of the following four divisions.**

- **The 08U Junior Rookie Ball Thursday division will play every Thursday and practice every second Tuesday.** Games will be every Thursday at 5:45 pm. Some games will take place at Christie Pits diamond 3 and some at the Bickford South diamond. The regular season schedule will list where the game is each week. Tuesday practices will take place at the Bickford South diamond from 5:30 to 6:45 pm.
- **The 08U Junior Rookie Ball Friday division will play every Friday and practice every second Wednesday.** Games will be at 5:45 and 7:00 p.m. at Christie Pits diamond 3 (each team will play some games at each time). Wednesday practices will take place at Christie Pits diamond 2 from 5:15 to 6:30 pm.
- **The 09U Senior Rookie Ball Monday division will play every Monday and practice every second Wednesday.** Games will be played each Monday at 5:45 and 7:00 pm (each team will play some games at each time). The games will take place at the Bickford South diamond. Wednesday practices will take place at the Bickford South diamond from 5:30 to 6:45 pm.
- **The 09U Senior Rookie Ball Thursday division will play every Thursday and practice every second Monday.** Games will be every Thursday at 7:00 pm at either the Bickford South diamond or Christie Pits diamond 3 (each team plays games at each diamond). Monday practices will take place at the Dovercourt diamond from 5:15 to 6:30 pm.

There will be workout sessions arranged for players registered in all Rookie Ball divisions that will take place before the last week of April. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. We are planning to hold some of these sessions indoors in March and April, as well as having outdoor sessions take place sometime in mid- to late April. Parents will receive information as to the dates, times, and location of these sessions as they are confirmed. But we want to emphasize that everyone who is registered has a spot and will be playing! These are not tryouts!

The pre-season practices for Rookie Ball teams will run, weather and field conditions permitting, from Monday April 27th to Thursday May 14th. There will be two or three scheduled **team practices** during the pre-season, as well as some batting practice sessions for Rookie Ball players to become more comfortable hitting against the pitching machine. **Team practices will be on one of the two "usual" nights for your division. The batting practice sessions will be held on the weekends of May 2nd and 3rd and May 9th and 10th.**

We will also be holding **weekend skill clinics in May and June** so the Rookie Ball players can further develop their skills. The dates, times and locations of those will be available in the coming weeks.

The Rookie Ball regular season will commence on Tuesday May 19th. The Rookie Ball season will wrap up with the Rookie Ball Celebration Day games, which will be played on the weekend of September 12th and 13th. The date, time and location of each team's Celebration Day game will be confirmed when the regular season schedule is released in late April or early May.

11U Mosquito (2016 and 2015)

For the 2026 season the 11U Mosquito division is for players born in 2016 and 2015. In 2026 the 11U Mosquito division will take place on Mondays and Wednesdays. So, **Mondays and Wednesdays are the days each week that 11U Mosquito players will need to commit to in order to participate in house league.**

All teams will play some games on Mondays and some games on Wednesdays (alternating each week). Practices will always be on Mondays. All teams will have a game every week and a practice every second week. So, all teams will have either a game or practice scheduled EVERY Monday, and all teams will have a game scheduled on Wednesday the weeks they practice on Mondays.

The teams in the 11U Mosquito division will be divided into two groups, and each team will play all of the other teams in their group (but not teams in the other group) during the regular season.

Games and practices in the 11U Mosquito division will take place at a number of diamonds in the community: Christie Pits diamonds 2 and 3, the Dovercourt diamond, and Trinity diamond 2 (in Trinity Bellwood Park). The start times for the games will range from 5:45 to 7:30 pm. Start times for practices will range from 5:30 to 7:00 pm.

Games will run from 1.5 hours to 1.75 hours, and practices will run for 1.5 hours. The schedule will be created so that all teams will play/practice at all of those diamonds and at all of the start times during the course of the season.

There will be workout sessions arranged for players registered in 11U Mosquito division that will take place before the last week of April. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. More detailed information regarding the End-of-Season House League tournament will be made available after registration opens next Friday January 16th.

13U Peewee (2014 and 2013)

For the 2026 season the 13U Peewee division is for players born in 2014 and 2013. In 2026 the 13U Peewee division will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays. So, **Tuesdays and Thursdays are the days each week that 13U Peewee players will need to commit to in order to participate in house league.**

All teams will play some games on Tuesdays and some games on Thursdays (alternating each week). Practices will always be on Thursdays. All teams will have a game every week and a practice every second week. So, all teams will have either a game or practice scheduled every Thursday, and all teams will have a game scheduled on Tuesday the weeks they practice on Thursday.

The teams in the 13U Peewee division will be divided into two groups, and each team will play all of the other teams in their group (but not teams in the other group) during the regular season.

Games and practices in the 13U Peewee division will take place at a number of diamonds in the community: Christie Pits diamonds 2 and 3, the Dovercourt diamond, and Trinity Bellwood diamond 2 (in Trinity Bellwood Park). The start times for the games will range from 5:45 to 7:45 pm. The start times for the practices will range from 5:30 to 8:15 pm.

Games will run from 1.5 hours to 1.75 hours, and practices will run for 1.5 hours. The schedule will be created so that all teams will play/practice at all of those diamonds and at all of the start times during the course of the season.

There will be workout sessions arranged for players registered in the 13U Peewee division that will take place before the last week of April. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. We are planning to hold some of these sessions indoors in March and April, as well as having outdoor sessions take place sometime in mid- to late April. 15U Bantam (2012 and 2011) and 18U Varsity (2010/2009/2008)

For the 2026 season, the 15U Bantam division is for players born in 2012 and 2011, and the 18U Varsity division is for players born in 2010, 2009, and 2008. There will be one 15U Bantam division and one 18U Varsity division. There will be four teams in the 18U Varsity division and there will be six teams in the 15U Bantam division.

Since there is only one available diamond with a mound there will be 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity games played on more than one day each week. The days on which there will always be both a 15U Bantam game and a 18U Varsity game scheduled are Sunday and Monday. On Sundays and Mondays there will be a 15U Bantam game starting at 6:00 pm and the 18U Varsity game will start at 8:00 pm.

The 18U Varsity teams will be scheduled for one game a week. The 15U Bantam teams will also be scheduled for one game a week. We are planning to play many of the additional third 15U Bantam games on Sunday afternoons when the Toronto Maple Leaf team does not have a home game. The rest of the additional third 15U Bantam games will be scheduled in the coming weeks and will be included on the house league schedule that is released in later April or early May.

We will be announcing the practice times and days for the 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity house league divisions by mid-May. While some practices will be at Christie Pits diamond 1, others will likely be at Christie Pits diamond 2.

There will be workout sessions arranged for players registered in the 15U Bantam and 18U Varsity divisions that will take place before the last week of April. The purpose of these sessions is to give us as good a measure as possible of the skill level of our players, so that we can make our house league teams as fair and balanced as possible. We are planning to hold some of these sessions indoors in March and April, as well as having outdoor sessions take place sometime in mid- to late April. Parents and players will receive information as to the dates, times, and location of these sessions as they are confirmed. But we want to emphasize that everyone who is registered has a spot and will be playing! These are not tryouts!

The 15U Bantam division regular season will commence during the week of Tuesday May 19th, and will wrap up in mid-September at the conclusion of our end-of-season “September Madness” house league tournament.

The 18U Varsity division regular season will commence on Sunday May 24th, and will wrap up at the conclusion of our end-of-season house league tournament. The timing of the house league tournament will be decided after we determine how many of the players in the Varsity house league division will be leaving Toronto by Labour Day to attend school out of town.

More detailed information regarding the End-of-Season House League tournament will be made available after registration opens next Friday January 16th.
